TRAFFIC REGULATION POLICY

Objective

To control the movement of vehicles within the campus giving paramount importance to the users of the vehicles and the pedestrians

Methodology

1. In-campus security will ensure that only authorized persons / residents / users of the university campus are permitted inside using a "Pass" system.
2. Users first time entering the campus shall be registered by the security and issued a temporary pass.
3. Posters, placards shall be placed in the campus mentioning the speed limits.
4. Separate parking spacs for two/four wheelers shall be provided.
5. Students shall be encouraged to use cycles in preference over motor vehicles.
6. Speed breakers shall be provided where required and warning signs shall be erected in such locations.
7. Security personnel will regulate traffic in the morning and evening using Walkie-Talkies and megaphones.
8. Separate walking platforms for pedestrains shall be provided.
9. Two wheelers without helmets shall not be permitted inside unless during emergency.
10. Wearing of Seat belts in four wheelers shall be made compulsory gradually.
11. Triple riding / rash driving in two wheelers shall not be permitted.

Implementation

Under the directorate of campus life, a dedicated associate director will implement the above stated methodology.
